This week in...

Reading: We read the story *My Friends*. In this story we learned how a young girl used her animal friends to teach things like how to run and jump.

Phonics: We continued our study of the short /i/ vowel sound. This week our spelling words include short /i/ and end in either *in* or *ill*.

Math: We learned how to write addition sentences horizontally and vertically. We also learned related addition facts for 0-10.

Writing: We learned how to plan complete sentences by naming a noun, a verb, and finishing the thought answering when, where, or how.

Science: We began our first FOSS kit this week titled Pebbles, Sand, and Silt. We learned how to identify rocks and what happens when we rub rocks together.
