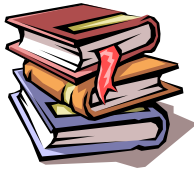

This week in language arts we are reading the story, The Little Red Hen. We have read several different copies of the same story and discussed the differences. The children sequenced the story and acted it out. Last week the children learned to recognize the letters and sounds for Ff and Ee. They glued feathers on the letter Ff and our mystery picture was the fox. This week we will spend more time focusing on the letter Ee.



The children have started a unit on money. We began talking about the penny. The children learned that when we count pennies, we count by one's. We have also been learning about tally marks. This week we will use tally marks to collect data and we will use that data to create pictographs and bar graphs. We will graph our favorite fruit and color.



We are still patiently waiting for our chicks to hatch. They were supposed to emerge this past weekend, but we think that due to the lower temperature in our incubator they may need a little more time to develop.

Next Wednesday, March 31, we will have our traditional Easter egg hunt at 2:40. You are welcome to come and watch as the children search for eggs out in the field.
